BEE CLEAN, CNH!

"BEE Clean, CNH!" focuses on **bettering the environment** and diverse landscapes. According to the *World Health Organization*, 1.7 million children under the age of five die annually and 570,000 children under the age of five die from respiratory infections due to air pollution. With the CNH District being the largest in Key Club International, Key Club members are encouraged to plan and participate in **environment-related service events** to combat and reverse pollution and its health-related impacts in America. During the month of July, you are encouraged to save lives through the simple acts of promoting the cleanliness of the Earth and spreading awareness of environmental impacts. What will you do to **BEE clean**?

SERVICE PROJECT IDEAS



COMMUNITY CLEANUP

Help reduce waste and pollution in your public communities by picking up trash! Consider areas that has a lot of litter like parks, beaches, neighborhoods, etc.. Just prepare supplies such as gloves, masks, trashbags, and start cleaning! Members can participate with their families during this time since clubs are unable to meet up.



PLANT A TREE PROJECT

Host a tree planting project where members can plant trees with their families at locations where their cities/communities allow! To ensure members are knowledgeable of the basics of tree planting, host a training or provide accurate researched information beforehand. Safety precautions must be taken by wearing gloves and masks.



ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS INFOGRAPHICS

Create graphics to educate others about the current state of our environment and how to reduce our carbon footprint! These infographics must be accurately researched and may include statistics, environmentally friendly lifestyle changes, the harmful effects of climate change, etc.. Education is key to environmental awareness and saving our planet!



RECYCLING DRIVE

Help reduce waste and keep our communities clean by holding a recycling drive! Ask members to gather recyclable materials like cans, bottles, cardboard, paper, recyclable e-waste, etc. and donate them to local recycling organizations. You may also host an event where members can repurpose these materials to make into something new!
